Role: Media and the Public Interest (MPI) Representative

Description:

The Media and Public Interest (MPI) Representative is responsible for being the voice of MPI students in years 2, 3, and 4, championing their concerns and viewpoints. In this role, you will take the lead in organizing engaging academic and social events catered to MPI students, fostering a vibrant community. Collaborating closely with the Advocacy Team and utilizing the FIMSSC as a platform, you'll promote MPI-related initiatives and ensure that first-year students are well-informed about this program's offerings.

Additional responsibilities include:

- Voicing the concerns and views of MPI students in years 2, 3 and 4;
- Organizing and executing academic and social events, catered to MPI students
- Sitting on the Advocacy Team as a member and representative of MPI
- Utilizing the FIMSSC as a forum to host, promote, and organize events related to mandatory MPI classes at the discretion of the FIMSSC
- Working in conjunction with FIMS administration to promote and inform first year/incoming students about MPI
- Administering the MPI Facebook Group
- Submitting a year-end report no later than the end of March and have at least one formal meeting with their successor to ensure smooth transition
- Carrying out any other duties determined by the FIMSSC
