Role: Advocacy Commissioner

Description:

The Advocacy Commissioner is responsible for raising awareness for pertinent issues which you are passionate about. In this role you are required to generate initiatives and events that help advocate for change within the faculty, at Western, and in our general society.

Additional responsibilities include:

- Working in conjunction with the Vice President Student Programming to organize and execute at least one charity initiative per semester
- Engaging in activist initiatives throughout the year which are relevant to the current social climate, and are primarily focused on raising awareness for pertinent issues rather funds or donations
- Submitting a year-end report no later than the end of March and have at least one formal meeting with their successor to ensure smooth transition
- Carrying out any other duties determined by the FIMSSC.
